Friday Facts <u>**UMMMMM - NO!!!!</u>** The State of Illinois' Pyrotechnic</u> Use Act ("PUA") bans the sale, possession, and use of all "consumer fireworks." Consumer fireworks is defined as firecrackers, bottle rockets, and roman candles. Violating the PUA can result in up to 1 year in prison and a \$2500 fine.

The Norridge Police Department will be strictly enforcing both state law and Village code in regards to fireworks. It is illegal for any person to possess, sell, use, display, ignite or explode any fireworks. Every year, thousands of people are injured due to firework mishaps. Leave the fireworks to the professionals.
