2015 Surface Patching Program

The improvements to be constructed are located at various location throughout the Village of Norridge. This improvement consists of the milling of deteriorated surface as directed by the Owner and the subsequent placement of 2" of HMA surface course. This work will consist of "hand work" operations on the smaller patches, and "machine work" operations on the large patches. The work on the smaller patches will be performed using a small grinder, while the work on the large patches will be performed utilizing a cold milling machine for the removal operations and a HMA paver for the installation of the surface material. The large patches are located in close proximity so that only one re-mobilization would be required.

Sealed bids will be received up to the hour of 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday; the 22nd day of September, 2015, in the office of the Village Clerk in the Village Hall located at 4000 North Olcott Avenue, Norridge, Illinois and will be publicly opened and read at that time.

All bid proposals offered must be accompanied by a bid bond in an amount not less than Ten Percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid or a cashier's check or certified check, made payable to the Order of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Norridge and in an amount not less than Ten Percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid, as a guarantee that if the bid proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of the contract properly secured. No bid proposal shall be considered unless accompanied by such bid bond or check.

A performance bond and a payment bond, each in the amount of One Hundred Percent (100%) of the contract price and with a corporate surety approved by the Village of Norridge, will be required from the successful bidder to guarantee the full performance of the contract.
