# FINANCE, LICENSES & CONTRACTS, Trustee Gregorio:

Trustee Gregorio read the following discussion item:

(a) The Illinois Department of Revenue (IDOR) has recently discovered incorrect Corporate Personal Property Replacement Tax (CPPRT) distributions to thousands of local taxing districts, which have been overpaid by \$168 million during the last two year. Of the approximately 6,500 taxing districts which were overpaid, Norridge is one of them. Once a recoupment process is established by the IDOR, the correct (future) payments will be reduced until the overpayment is has been offset. The amount overpaid to Norridge is \$3,453.70.

Trustee Gregorio asked if there were any questions or modifications to her consent agenda items (a) thru (d). There were none.

- (c) Accept ACH payment from the Illinois Comptroller's Office, dated March 14, 2016, in the amount of \$573,604.42 for the Village's share of Sales Tax.
- (d) Accept Intergovernmental Agreement among the Village of Norridge, Cook County, Illinois and Ridgewood Community High School District 234 and the Village of Harwood Heights, Illinois and enter into agreement with for the purposes of providing a Police Officer, to be serve in the capacity as a Police Liaison and School Resource Officer as detailed in the contract. The agreement shall commence on July 01, 2016 and end on June 30, 2017.
