President Chmura asked Clerk Budnik to read the public notice published in the Pioneer Press/ Norridge and Harwood Heights News on June 9, 2016.

Clerk Budnik read the notice which included the budget summary for all departments.

Trustee Gregorio presented the proposed Village Budget for Fiscal Year May 01, 2016 to April 30, 2017 as previously presented to the Village Board by the President on June 8, 2016.

President Chmura opened the meeting for public comments and suggestions.

## Riccardo Mora

Mr. Mora objected to the trash can removal program. He requested information from other villages/towns and found many villages receive the cans for free from the disposal companies. The disposal companies distribute and maintain the cans.

Mr. Mora stated problems could be solved by requiring residents to use closed cans or containers only. The village should not pay any money for this program.

Mr. Mora stated a possible coincidence with contributions Bosman has made in the

past to the Norridge Improvement Party that correlates with the current trash can program. Previously Bosman had mad 14 contributions of \$500 to the party. The last contribution was for \$3000 when the garbage can program started. He asked the board to revisit and enforce rules. Don't pay \$250,000 for cans. Let Bosman pay.

There were no other public comments or suggestions.
