RE: Disconnection of Lawn Irrigation Systems

Below are the general steps for your plumber to disconnect the lawn irrigation system.

- 1. Turn off the water to your lawn irrigation system.
- 2. Cut the irrigation system water supply line after the water supply valve- in your house. Unused sections of water service or water distribution piping ("dead ends"), where the water in the piping may become stagnant, are prohibited. A developed length of more than 2 feet shall be considered a dead end. (section 890.1200) of the Illinois Plumbing Code.
- 3. Outside Cut the water line 2" above the ground.
- 4. Remove the backflow preventer and the valves and pipes attached to it.
- 5. Cap the pipe end in your house, and the pipe end entering the ground.
- 6. Fill the hole in your wall with an appropriate material of your choice.
- 7. Call 708-453-0319 to arrange an inspection of the disconnection.
- 8. Sign the Certification for Inactive Irrigation System.
