On April 27<sup>th</sup>, Village President Daniel Tannhauser signed Supplement #2 to his Executive Orders dated March 23<sup>rd</sup> & April 8<sup>th</sup>. However, we would like to highlight the following:

Due to the Governor's Stay-at-Home Order that is now in effect through May 30<sup>th</sup>, the Village has postponed Coffee and Conversation with the President, the Car Show and Spring Clean Up week. The May 24<sup>th</sup> Memorial Day Observance Ceremony will be closed to the public, however, President Tannhauser will lay a wreath at the Memorial to honor all who have made the ultimate sacrifice.

The Norridge Village Hall lobby continues to be closed to the public through May 30<sup>th</sup>, however, we are available by phone and email to serve your needs Monday through Friday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

Vehicle stickers and pet licenses renewals will be processed by mail only until the Village Hall lobby reopens to the public. You can mail in your preprinted application with payment using the green envelope provided, or drop your preprinted application with payment at the Village Hall in the slot marked WATER BILL PAYMENTS & VEHICLE STICKER APPLICATIONS DEPOSITED HERE." Your sticker and/or pet license will be mailed back to you.

Street maintenance enforcement will be suspended through May 30<sup>th</sup>. Public Works, in an effort to keep our streets clean of debris, will continue to sweep open areas.

The Pace Bus service continues to be suspended through May 30<sup>th</sup>.

Garbage, recycling and yard waste pick up will continue as normal. However, please remember that all trash must be put in a tied plastic bag and placed in your garbage cart.

Beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>, face coverings are required to be worn by all individual when in public places and when not able to maintain adequate social distancing. Face coverings will also be required in public indoor spaces. Cloth masks, scarves or bandanas can be used as face coverings.

We continue to receive updates from the Centers for Disease Control, the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, as well as the Office of the Governor. Any updates will be posted on our website, Facebook page and Community Bulletin Board (Comcast Channel 6) in addition to using this mass communication system.
