Hello, this is the Village of Norridge calling to inform you of some changes that are a result of Governor Pritzker moving the State of Illinois into Phase 3 of his Restore Illinois Plan. These changes are effective Monday, June 1st.

The Village Hall and the Police Station lobby will reopen to the public on June 1, for essential business only. You are required to have a face covering in order to enter the building, as well as adhere to social distancing. Hours of 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM at Village Hall are reserved for seniors and for vulnerable customers. Please be respectful of this provision. Non-essential payments such as water bills or vehicle stickers should be handled without entering the building and via the outside drop box.

Street maintenance will resume, and enforcement will begin on June 1.

As part of Phase 3, restaurants and bars may offer outdoor seating and service. Offices, retail, barbershops and salons can also reopen to the public with capacity and other limits and safety precautions. The Pace Bus service continues to be suspended until further notice. Block parties will not be allowed for the remainder of the year and no permits will be issued.

Garage and estate sales are also prohibited until further notice.
