Hello, this is the Village of Norridge calling to remind you that with the forecast of 5-8 inches of snow over night tonight, if you live in a designated snow route, please make sure you move your car off the street. Cars that have not been moved, will be ticketed and/or towed. You may begin parking back on the street after the snowplows have cleared your street.

Snow route streets are clearly marked with signage. A map of the snow route areas can be found on our website at www.villageofnorridge.com. You may also verify that snow route enforcement is in effect by calling the snow route hotline at 708-583-5775.

For those who live in the historic section and do not have a driveway, please make every effort to move your car a few times during snow removal.

As a reminder, weekly Street Maintenance enforcement will also be in effect on your regularly scheduled day. Village Ordinance prohibits anyone from snow blowing or shoveling snow into the street. This will make for hazardous travel conditions. If you throw snow into the street, you will receive a ticket.
