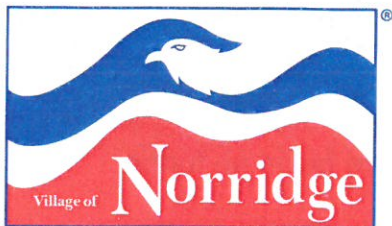


## MINUTES – BUDGET HEARING

### PUBLIC HEARING – VILLAGE BUDGET

Clerk Krasinski read aloud the legal notice posted in the Village Hall lobby and published in the Norridge and Harwood Heights News on June 10, 2021 regarding the Public Hearing to be held on Wednesday, June 23, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in regard to the Village Budget for the Fiscal Year May 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022.

Trustee Avino presented to the public the proposed Village Budget for Fiscal Year May 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022.

Trustee Budnik asked to clarify the difference in decline of amusement tax and if Village will recoup.

- Administrator Skupian replied that the Village in 2020 lost Go Bananas, Putting Edge and Laser Tag which contributes to the decline of receiving amusement tax. Only amusement tax at this moment is and will be from AMC Theater.


Trustee Budnik mentioned the Police Chief pay being less than last year due to the new chief not being named until later in the year. She mentioned the budgeted salary is a little less for that reason. Also increased the salary for the Deputy Chief/Commander to take into account the possibility of when a new chief is named he may consider adding an additional position under his command. If the new chief does he would consider the increase in staff for the future as well. We would like to increase our police staff and not reduce at this point.
