

# **RECYCLING PROGRAM:**

- Please place only approved items in recycling can. Any foreign
  material present will result in in the bin being left or contents
  thrown away with the refuse/garbage.
- Flatten all corrugated cardboard boxes and paperboard/chipboard then bundle, bag in paper bag, or put in can.
- Do not place any recyclable items in plastic bags or put plastic bags in with your recycling.
- Please make sure all cans are at the curb and under 50lbs
- If you are not sure if am item is recycling or not, please put it with the refuse/garbage.
- Please only use village approved recycling bins.

### **ALLOWED ITEMS:**

#### PLASTIC ITEMS:

• Clean bottles and containers with the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7

#### PAPER ITEMS:

- Office paper (printer paper, school paper)
- Newspaper
- Magazines/catalogs
- Paperboard/Chipboard (cereal, pasta, soda, or clothing boxes)
- Brown paper bags *No plastic grocery bags.*
- Aseptic containers (Juice & Milk cartons)

### **METAL ITEMS:**

- Aluminum cans
- Steel or tin cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Aluminum foil
- · Aluminum baking trays

#### GLASS ITEMS:

- · Bottles and Jars only
- Brown, green & clear jars
- No mirrors, window glass or porcelain accepted.

## **ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:**

- No plastic bags, films or bubble wrap
- Foam/Styrofoam
- Food waste
- Pizza Boxes
- Electronics and cords
- Batteries
- Toner/ink cartridges
- Used napkins, paper towels & tissues.
- Liquids
- Rubber hoses
- Plastic Cutlery, straws or other #6 plastics
- Poly-lined beverage cups (Disposable coffee cups)
