We frequently hear... “Can I rake leaves into the street to be picked up?”

Now that fall is upon us, we will soon begin observing more and more leaves on the ground. As a reminder, Village Ordinance states that it is unlawful to rake leaves into the street. **PLEASE DO NOT RAKE LEAVES INTO THE STREETS!!!**

The reason for this is leaves block the sewers, plug the drains, cause damage to the street sweeper and create a safety hazard when the streets are wet or frost-covered.

Put leaves, vines, brush and clippings in either brown yard waste paper bags or in properly marked yard waste containers. Complimentary “Yard Waste Only” stickers are available at the Norridge Village Hall. Bosman Disposal will haul them away on garbage day.

As a reminder, yard waste pick up ends for the season on November 30th, and resumes on April 1st each year.

Thank you for your cooperation. With everyone’s help, we can keep our streets clean, neat and safe.
