#### LAW & ORDINANCE & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, Trustee Bielak:

Trustee Avino for Trustee Bielak had no discussion items for review. He asked if there were any questions regarding the consent agenda. There were none.

**MOTION:** by Trustee Avino second by Trustee Budnik to:

(a) Refer the issue of a text and map amendment under Article XV Section 5 of the Village of Norridge Zoning Ordinance - 1962 amending Article XI-B Cannabis Overlay District ("CO Overlay District") Section 4, which sets the boundaries and defines the areas in business and commercial zoning districts that are included in the CO Overlay District, to the Zoning Board of Appeals for a public hearing and their recommendation to the Village Board of Trustees, as follows:

- 1. Repealing the text of Section 4.1 listing the Permanent Index Numbers contained in Area 1 and replacing the text with boundary line descriptions of Area 1 and replacing the Area 1 map with a map showing the Area 1 boundary lines and Area 1 section of the CO Overlay District superimposed on a Sidwell map.
- 2. Repealing the text of Section 4.2 listing the Permanent Index Numbers contained in Area 2 and replacing the text with boundary line descriptions of Area 2, repealing the Area 2 map and replacing the Area 2 map with a revised map excluding the area which is comprised of Permanent Index Numbers 13-18-318-005-0000; 13-18-318-006-0000; 13-18-318-007-0000; 13-18-318-008-0000 commonly known as Norridge Gardens having the address 7001 West Cullom Avenue which is a residential use, and showing the Area 2 boundary lines and Area 2 section of the CO Overlay District superimposed on a Sidwell map.
- 3. Repealing the text of Section 4.3 listing the Permanent Index Numbers contained in Area 3 and replacing the text with boundary line descriptions of Area 3 and replacing the Area 3 map with a map showing the Area 3 boundary lines and Area 3 section of the CO Overlay District superimposed on a Sidwell map.
- 4. Repealing the text of Section 4.4 listing the Permanent Index Numbers contained in Area 4 and replacing the text with boundary line descriptions of Area 4 and replacing the Area 4 map with a map showing the Area 4 boundary lines and Area 4 section of the CO Overlay District superimposed on a Sidwell map.

Trustee Budnik asked Joan Cherry our Village Attorney, what is changing and needed more clarification. Ms. Cherry stated that the Pin number will be removed and actual description will be in the ordinance.

(b) Adopt and approve Ordinance No. 2116-23, "AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2023 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2024: An Ordinance for the Levy of a Real Estate Tax for the Police Pension Fund," the President and Clerk to be authorized to sign, the Clerk be directed to publish in pamphlet form.

- (c) Accept proposal dated August 17, 2023 from KLM Engineering Inc., for the purpose of consulting and inspection services during the rehabilitation of the 250,000 gallon single pedestal elevated water storage tank located at 7249 W. Montrose Avenue (southeast corner of Montrose Avenue & Octavia Avenue), which includes services related to the procurement of bids, amount not to exceed \$90,749.00. Billing will not begin until Fiscal Year 2025 and payments will not be due until on or after May 1, 2024.
