

Did you know..... The Village of Norridge has a Veterans Affairs Department?

The Veterans Affairs office is located in the Estelle Sieb Center at 7774 W. Irving Park Road. Our Veterans Affairs Coordinator, Raymond Murphy, is responsible for helping many Veterans and their families receive the benefits they are entitled to for serving in the military.

The Federal Department of Veterans Affairs benefits include hospitalization; medication; outpatient care; G.I. Home loans; war era veteran and spousal pensions; disability compensation; medical care for spouses, surviving spouses, and dependents; G.I. life insurance; burial allowances and grave markers; specially adapted housing and vehicle grants, and much more. In addition, the Illinois Department of Veterans Affairs oversees a network of state Veterans Homes and a scholarship program for children of MIAs/POWs.
