We have been asked... "Why didn't my yard waste get picked up?"

Now that the warmer weather is here, our minds have turned to yard and garden clean up and the planting of flower and vegetable gardens. We have been receiving calls from residents on how to dispose of their yard waste.

Yard waste pick-up runs from April 1st through November 30th. Residents can dispose of grass clippings, weeds, leaves, etc., by using disposable yard waste brown bags that are for sale at hardware or grocery stores. Another option is to an open 30-gallon container that must be marked YARD WASTE ONLY. (Please do not use your Village issued black garbage cart, or green or blue recycling carts), "Yard Waste Only" stickers are available at the Norridge Village Hall. The yard waste bags, or container must be placed next to your garbage cart on your regular garbage day.

Large bushes or branches can be disposed of if prepared properly. The bushes or branches must be cut into four foot lengths and tied together so that they can be easily lifted into the garbage truck. Yard waste, bushes or branches not properly prepared will not be picked up.
