

# Friday Facts

*We are being asked.. “Will there be a change to my garbage pick-up next week?”*

The #1 question received at the Village Hall is in regards to garbage pick-up after a holiday. The Village Hall will be closed Monday, May 27th for the Memorial Day holiday. Therefore, garbage pick-up will be one day later for the entire week. This means, Monday’s garbage will be picked-up on

Tuesday, Tuesday’s garbage will be picked-up on Wednesday, and so on for the rest of this week. As a reminder, the Village of Norridge has only 6 holidays that alter weekly pick-up days:

New Year’s Day  
Memorial Day  
4th of July  
Labor Day  
Thanksgiving Day  
Christmas Day

Your garbage will be picked up one day later for the rest of that week for these holidays **ONLY**. (If your pick-up day is on a Friday, your garbage will be picked up on Saturday). Garbage will be picked up on your regularly scheduled day on all other National or State Holidays other than the ones listed above.

Please remember - Village ordinance states that you may put your garbage out after 6:00 P.M. on the night before your scheduled day. Garbage is to be placed in your Village-issued black garbage cart and recycling must be placed in either the green recycling bins, or blue recycling carts.
